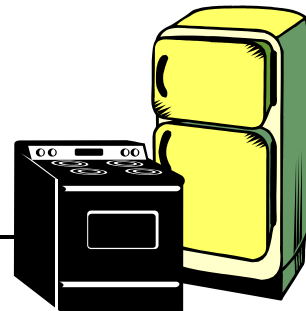




Chelan County Cleanup Days (White Goods and Scrap Metal Recycling) March 31, 2012



Items Accepted:

Large appliances such as hot water tanks, 6 foot pipe lengths or less, dryers, steel bath tubs, aluminum siding, bikes, lawnmowers, wheel rims, refrigerators, freezers, air-conditioners at most sites (see below purging fees)

See specific sites for whether automobiles, orchard sprayers, and refrigeration units are accepted (*vehicles and trailers must have titles and have fluids and tires removed).

Items not Accepted:

Cable, pressurized tanks, propane tanks, sprayers, mattresses, gas cylinders, light ballast, non-aluminum canopies/campers, travel trailers, enclosed barrels, plastics or garbage.

This list is not all-inclusive. We reserve the right to reject any items.

Wenatchee: 1450 S. Wenatchee Ave.

(across from Waste Management Transfer Station)

8 a.m. – 3 p.m. Only scrap metal and non-Freon appliances accepted. Autos, Sprayers, and Refrigeration Units not accepted

Malaga: W. Malaga Road

(County Pit, west of Malaga Fire Station)

8 a.m. – 3 p.m. Refrigeration Units, Sprayers & Automobiles **are** accepted.

Dryden: Dryden Transfer Station, Hwy 2

9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Refrigeration Units, Sprayers & Automobiles **are** accepted

Entiat: City of Entiat Gravel Pit

9 a.m.-3 p.m. Refrigeration units & Sprayers accepted here. Autos not accepted.

Chelan: Rowe's Wrecking Yard

9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Refrigeration Units, Automobiles & Batteries **are** accepted

* Motorized items such as vehicles, trailers, and motorbikes **must have a title. Contact the Sheriff's Office for lost titles at 667-6851. Motorized units must have fluids and tires removed.** If orchard sprayers are accepted; please rinse and prepare to remove tires.



Tires and batteries can be taken to Discount Tire in Wenatchee, T.D.S. Tires in Wenatchee and Les Schwab only in Chelan. Fees vary by style; \$3.00-\$4.00 is charged for passenger tires and an additional \$2.00 - \$4.00 for tires on rims.

There will be a **\$20.00 purging fee** for any appliances that contain, or once contained freon. All other metal is free for disposal. All hazardous waste fluids must be removed from automotive items, including engines and transmission cases.
